- To provide a microarray experiment service facility where the scientist provides samples of RNA (or DNA), and the CDMC performs the labelling, hybridization and scanning.
In addition, we are committed to:
 - Providing information and protocols for the use of the *Drosophila* microarrays.
- Supplying individual EST clones used to make the array for a nominal cost.
- Supporting the creation and use of a *Drosophila* microarray experiment database and analysis software.
